

Be a Koala Watcher

If you have koalas living near you:

Search for koalas:

 Look for scats and determine if they are healthy ones that are firm, cylindrical, brownish/olive greenish.



Look for scratch marks on trees.







- Listen for bellowing, grunting, yipping noises.
- Look for koala shapes. Adults are soccer ball size. Joeys are rock melon size.

Once you find a koala:

- Observe how it looks including its nose pattern, ear shape, facial features and fur markings.
- Watch it often and record what it does and when it is active. Use binoculars or a zoom lens if you can.
- Give it a name you'll remember.
- Learn its favourite trees and perches.
